Mission of SHIR CHADASH:

2. **Accessible** – The service should include English prayers and explanations of Hebrew prayers. No part of the service should be opaque, unintelligible, or seem foreign to the unaccustomed worshipper.
3. **Relevant** – The service should acknowledge contemporary realities and address the needs of the modern spiritual seeker.
4. **Beautiful** – The music of the service should be beautiful and inspirational.
5. **Educational** – The service should teach worshippers about Torah, Prayers, Judaism, Israel, and/or Holidays.
