

RESOLUTION #1

WHEREAS, Tikun Olam, repairing the world is a central tenet of Conservative Judaism; and

WHEREAS, The continuing decline in the quality of our natural environment is of concern to the entire community; and

WHEREAS, careful use of our natural resources is an important part of maintaining our natural environment

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Regional Board of the New Jersey Region of the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism that it does endorse the principles set forth on Schedule A attached to this Resolution; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Region is authorized to sign the endorsement referred to above; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board does encourage our affiliate congregations to review these principles on their own and to adopt these principles for themselves.

RESOLUTION #2

WHEREAS The New Jersey Region of the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism provides valuable services and support to its affiliated congregations in the region; and

WHEREAS The New Jersey Region is supported primarily by the dues paid by its affiliated congregations; and

WHEREAS it is important that all affiliated congregations share in the benefits and burdens of membership

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY The Regional Board of the New Jersey Region of the United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism that it does authorize the Executive Committee of the Region to take all necessary and appropriate actions to ensure that all affiliated congregations pay their fair share of the cost of operating the region and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Region Executive Committee be authorized to consider all available information (including newspaper articles, advertisements, clergy recruitment applications, etc., but not the mailing list for the United Synagogue Review) to determine the accuracy of information submitted by our member congregations, so that each congregations dues obligation may be fairly determined; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Executive Committee is authorized to request such supporting documentation as necessary to confirm the information supplied to the Regional Office by a member congregation; and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Regional Executive Committee is authorized to propose adjustments to a congregation's dues obligation to the National Dues Committee and that all records will correctly reflect a congregation's financial hardship.
