## SAFETY PLAN TEMPLATE

Mandated Reporting laws must be followed prior to creating a safety plan. This template is intended to be used after a mandated report has been made. There are many reportable situations in which an external protective agency may delay investigation, choose not to investigate, or be unable to substantiate the report. In those cases, this template can assist minors who may be in danger either due to their own mental health or due to an abusive/neglectful home environment.

#### SOURCES OF SUPPORT

(List the names & contact information for those that may be able to support, help cope, or keep this person safe) Ex: Neighbor, friend, family member, rabbi, teacher, therapist, local Department of Children and Families/Child Protective Services, local non-emergency line.

(List all coping strategies)

Ex: Speak with one or more source of support.
