

SHARE YOUR JOY: ENTER THE JEWISH YOUTH FOR UNITY PHOTOJOURNALISM PROJECT & CONTEST!

What is the Jewish Youth for Unity Photojournalism Project & Contest?

This project invites teens in 8th-12th grades to share their perspective, through photography, on the Jewish values of *kindness*, *spreading joy*, and *giving*. To enter the contest, teens submit an original photo, plus a short description (up to 100 words) about how their photo reflects these values.

When does the contest take place?

The contest is open now! The last day to submit photos to be eligible for consideration is December 15 at 11:59 PM ET. The winning photos, <u>based on the number of likes on the @JewishYouthForUnity</u> Instagram account as of December 18 at 11:59 PM ET, will be announced the following day.

What are the prizes?

The 5 photos with the most likes on the @JewishYouthForUnity Instagram account will win:

- 1st place: \$2,000 towards college or a gap year in Israel
- 2nd place: \$1,000 towards college or a gap year in Israel
- 3rd place: \$500 towards college or a gap year in Israel
- 4th place: \$100 Amazon gift card
- 5th place: \$50 Amazon gift card

PLUS, the winning photos will be made available to be sent as digital greeting cards this holiday season!

Who is eligible to enter?

Any teen in 8th–12th grade, anywhere in the world, regardless of background, is eligible to enter.

Do I need to have special skills or equipment?

Nope! Anyone with a phone and a spark of creativity should participate.

Does my photo need to have been taken specifically for this project?

As long as you are the one who took it, any photo that represents the Jewish values of *kindness*, *spreading joy*, or *giving* is eligible.

Can I submit more than one photo?

Yes! But each person is only eligible to win one prize.

Is photo editing allowed?

Basic light, color, and exposure adjustments are allowed, but heavy manipulation or the use of Algenerated enhancements are not.

How do I enter?

Visit the contest <u>submission form</u>, enter your information, and submit your photo! That's it – it's easy!
